

International Artists' Camp, Seminar and Symposium 2018

Introduction-

First ever International Artists' Camp, Seminar and Symposium is planned to be held at Konark from 30th November to 5th December-2018. This camp is being organised by Odisha Lalit Kala Akademi, Department of Odia Language, Literature & Culture, Govt. of Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

- About 20(twenty) Artists are expected to participate in the Camp consisting of 10(ten) International Artists, 5(five) National Artists and 5 (five) Artists from the state of Odisha.
- Artists intending to participate in the camp will have to apply to Odisha Lalit Kala Akademi in the address given below duly enclosing their brief biodata, passport size photographs, five numbers photographs of recent best art works.
- Last date for submission of application is 30th September-2018.
- Applicants would be shortlisted for participation in the camp by a sub-committee of Odisha Lalit Kala Akademi.
- International Artists as selected by the sub-committee will travel to India duly bearing the travel from their country to India and also return back their country from their own source. The Akademi will however, reimburse the travel expenses by Air fare(Economy class)/First AC train fare incurred by the International Artists within India from the city where they arrive in India up to Odisha (Bhubaneswar). This portion of Air fare within India would be borne by Odisha Lalit Kala Akademi both to and fro.
- International Artists are required to have their health insurance prior to reaching India.

- Travel expenses of National and State Artists to Odisha would be reimbursed by Air fare (Economy class)/First AC Train fare to and from by the Odisha Lalit Kala Akademi.
- Local hospitality including accommodation, lodging and boarding would be borne by the Akademi during the period of the camp.
- International Artists would receive an honorarium of Rs. 75,000(Seventy Five Thousand only) and National/State Artists would be paid an honorarium of Rs. 50,000(Fifty Thousand only).
- Each Artist would prepare one Painting (size- 4' X 4') in the camp. The camp product works will be the property of the Akademi.
- All the camp product paintings will be an exhibition at Buddha Art Gallery (own Art Gallery) of Odisha Lalit Kala Akademi, Bhubaneswar, from 6th to 10th December 2018 daily 11.A.M. to 7 P.M.. A grand inaugural function with all the participate artists will be held on 6th December, 2018 at 6 P.M.
